Workshop 3

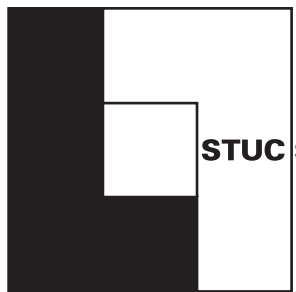
Funding: ULRs Engage with ILA Scotland
