Workshop info:

Scottish Union Learning will Chair the Union Learning Development Day to ensure contextualisation with the role of the ULR.

The workshops have been developed in response to previous iterations of Union Learning Development Days. Fife and Tayside TUCs will present on local union-led activities and how ULRs can get involved.

Dyslexia Scotland will deliver a workshop on Neurodiversity Awareness for ULRs. The workshop will focus on Dyslexia Awareness in the workplace but will touch on other co-occurring challenges.
