Workshop info:

Scottish Union Learning will Chair the Union Learning Development Day to ensure contextualisation with the role of the ULR.

The workshops have been developed in response to previous iterations of Union Learning Development Days. Glasgow Trades Council will present on local union-led activities and how ULRs can get involved.

Dyslexia Scotland will deliver a workshop on Neurodiversity Awareness for ULRs. The workshop will focus on Dyslexia Awareness in the workplace but will touch on other co-occurring challenges.

STUC Trade Unions in the Community will deliver a workshop on 'Our Rights in Action', a project which aims to build and strengthen workers' collective power by:

- Working closely with local Trades Councils, Unions, Workers and Community Members/Organisations
- Delivering tailored employment rights training

- Ensuring workers have the resources, confidence and collective strength to secure fair work and achieve sustainable change.
